

# A VAUGIRARD Sampler

VAUGIRARD is a new music-theatre work created and composed by Mardi-Ellen Hill.

Travel through la rue de Vaugirard as it winds and spins, embedding itself deeper and deeper into the vault of history and time...

VAUGIRARD explores the many faces of la rue de Vaugirard, an old Roman road and the longest street in Paris. Central character, Odette, moves backwards from the present to the past through images evoked from dream and memory. Written both in English and French, alternating back and forth between the two languages, the work is about crossing and turning, marking and moving through time and about change which creeps up and takes over with mighty force. VAUGIRARD will be presented at a two week residency program in August 1993 at the Performing Arts Center, SUNY Purchase. The first formal showing of excerpts from VAUGIRARD is planned for the fall of 1994 by the Works and Process at the Guggenheim series.
